

ROCHESTER KNITTING GUILD "KATE-ALONG"!

The Rochester Knitting Guild is sponsoring a "Kate-along" that will run until the March, 2018 meeting. We are encouraging members to knit patterns designed by Kate Atherley, our Guest Instructor for the Spring 2018 Workshops. She has many free patterns on Ravelry and Knitty.com, and our Library has acquired several of her books, including the most recent *Custom Fit Socks* book, which is terrific. We also have several of her instructional videos. Kate also has many Craftsy and Annie's classes as well as free videos.

We invite members to bring their projects knit from Kate Atherley's patterns for a Special Show & Tell at each meeting, starting in October. You can enter each project in a raffle drawing to win a seat at one of the Spring 2018 Workshop classes!

Participants who choose to enter project(s) in the raffle are subject to the guidelines below. We will have a raffle-style drawing at three meetings: November, January and March. Items submitted in September, October and November will be included in the November drawing; for December and January in the January drawing; and February and March in the March drawing. Each winner one will win a class of their choice (with available seats) for the Spring 2018 Workshops with Kate Atherley!

For the Kate-along drawing, we will have some guidelines:

1. Any Kate Atherley designed pattern that a Member has knit is eligible for the Kate-along, but the project must have been knit by a registered 2017-18 member!
2. Finished projects only--nothing on the needles or clearly unfinished (like parts unassembled etc.).
3. Members should bring a copy of the project pattern along with the item that they are submitting for the Kate-along drawing. If they do not have a copy of the pattern, project patterns can be validated by checking on Ravelry, so they MUST know the name of the pattern. We reserve the right to disallow a project if it bears little or no resemblance to Kate's pattern.
4. A project may be submitted ONLY ONCE for the Kate-Along drawing. Each registrant will fill out a form that includes their info and the name of the project. We may also keep a "photo album" that we can post on the website (with permission) and/or on Ravelry (with permission).
5. The Kate-along items for each meeting will be part of our regular Show & Tell, but participation in the Show & Tell will not qualify for the Kate-along drawing unless the form has been completed.
6. The winner can only select a "prize" class if there are seats available in that class at the time that they win. Any requests for exchanges to a different class after the initial selection is at the discretion of the Workshop Committee.
