Her knitwear designs are known for their ability to turn an abstract idea into a wearable reality while simultaneously fitting and complimenting a wide range of bodies. She lives and works in the woods of Central Ontario, Canada.

Our 2022 Guild Workshops will feature Kim's amazing classes that explore the tools and techniques to make sweaters that fit every bod—you will learn how to design or adjust patterns to fit YOU just right. The classes progress from learning how to properly measure your body to deep dives into how to make the adjustments that can make all the difference. The **Bums & Bellies** class will help you learn how to adjust or "hybridize" patterns to adjust when your weight is carried more in front or back. **Boob Camp** will focus on how, when and what type of darts work for your body, and at **Boob Camp 2** you'll learn the best necklines for your bust size, neck length and shoulder shape.
