

Tips from the Help Table

Grommets: the Hole Solution

Every so often, I just have to felt something. I love to see the giant, floppy bag turn into a compact, sturdy bag. I usually knit a separate handle so that I can easily replace it or adjust its length. That means I have to knit holes along the top of the bag. It didn't take long to discover that the holes were susceptible to wear, and I would haveto stitch a reinforcement to keep the holes from tearing. The problem is abrasion—the strap wears away at the hole (and the hole wears away at the strap).

Fortunately, there's a simple fix: grommets. A grommet is a two-piece eyelet placed in the hole to strengthen and protect against wear. One piece is a grommet washer; the other is a washer with a neck. It requires a grommeting tool consisting mainly of a die and an anvil to set the grommet.

Other than the grommets themselves, the only other tool you need is a hammer.

For your purposes, you can find a variety of grommets and setting tools and craft stores like Michaels. For smaller holes, there are decorative grommets in shapes like stars and flowers. For plain ring grommets, you can find silver and brass-toned ones in sizes like 3/8" and 5/8". Each diameter and shape of the grommet requires its own size setting setting tool, but ring grommets come in standard sizes, so if you always use one size grommet, it can be of any brand, and your tool will work.

Look on-line to find good videos for grommet setting.

Grommets: they are the whole hole solution.
